

What are the Davidic covenant's gracious provisions?

"Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever" (NASB; II Sam. 7:16).

"I have made a covenant with My chosen; I have sworn to David My servant, I will establish your seed forever and build up your throne to all generations. . . My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever, and My covenant shall be confirmed to him. So I will establish his descendants forever and his throne as the days of heaven" (NASB; Ps. 89:3-4, 28-29).

"He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end" (NASB; Lk. 1:32-33).

The Davidic covenant's gracious provisions are God's promises that David's seed, kingdom, and throne would be established forever, all of which are fulfilled in David's ultimate descendant, the Lord Jesus Christ.
